Requested Contributions

Late-breaking and Speculative Results

Significant and original ideas and promising approaches that are in an early stage and have not been verified and tested sufficiently to meet the requirements of a scientific publication. Submissions in this area will be evaluated like a scientific paper but limited to the aspects of originality, relevance, and significance.

Systems and Software Development Results

Descriptions of new systems or software products which are developed as a result of research activity. Systems will be evaluated based on novelty and significance of the application. Please consult the exhibition chair if you want to make a demonstration.

Projects and Initiatives

Descriptions of the objectives and results of ongoing projects and initiatives. The aim is to provide an overview of ongoing work in the area of software engineering.

Contributions in this area will be evaluated based on the importance and uniqueness of the objectives. Further criteria for project descriptions are the significance of the results and the expected impact on the community.

Submissions Format and Procedure

Please submit the abstract of a poster (not exceeding 1/2 page in length, not including any figures and tables) optionally with a poster draft by the deadline as an attached PDF or MS office file by e-mail to:

The abstract should include title, authors, and full contact information. Inclusion of the poster abstracts in the conference proceedings as Poster session summary is currently under negotiation.
